ARDOT - STANDARD BID CONDITIONS

- 1. **GENERAL:** Any special terms and conditions included in the invitation for bid override these standard terms and conditions. The standard terms and conditions and any special terms and conditions become part of any contract entered into if any or all parts of the bid are accepted by the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT).
- 2. **ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION:** ARDOT reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept bids in whole or in part (unless otherwise indicated by bidder), to waive any informalities in bids received, to accept bids on materials or equipment with variations from specifications where efficiency of operation will not be impaired, and to award bids to best serve the interest of the State.
- 3. **PRICES:** Unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, the following will apply: (1) unit prices shall be bid, (2) prices should be stated in units of quantity specified (feet, each, lbs., etc.), (3) prices must be F.O.B. destination specified in bid, (4) prices must be firm and not subject to escalation, (5) bid must be firm for acceptance for 30 days from bid opening date. In case of errors in extension, unit prices shall govern. Discounts from bid price will not be considered in making awards.
- BID BONDS AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: If required, a Bid Bond in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety company, in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation, must accompany bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Bid Bonds. Failure to submit a Bid Bond as required will cause a bid to be rejected. The Bid Bond will be forfeited as liquidated damages if the successful bidder fails to provide a required Performance Bond within the period stipulated by ARDOT or fails to honor their bid. When a bidder claims and can show clear and convincing evidence that a material mistake was made in the bid and was not the bid intended, the bidder may be permitted to withdraw their bid prior to award without forfeiture of bid bond. Cashier's checks and certified checks submitted as Bid Bonds will be returned to unsuccessful bidders; surety bonds will be retained. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation and in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety company, unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, as a guarantee of delivery of goods/services in accordance with the specifications and within the time established in the bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Performance Bonds. In some cases, a cashier's check or certified check submitted as a Bid Bond will be held as the Performance Bond of the successful bidder. Cashier's checks or certified checks submitted as Performance Bonds will be refunded shortly after payment has been made to the successful bidder for completion of all terms of the bid; surety bonds will be retained. Surety bonds must be issued by a surety company that is authorized to do business in the State of Arkansas and that is listed on the current United States Department of the Treasury Listing of Approved Sureties. Surety bonds must be executed by a resident or non-resident agent who is licensed by the Arkansas State Insurance Commissioner to represent the surety company executing the bond, and the resident or non-resident agent shall file with the bond the power of attorney of the agent to act on behalf of the bonding company. Certain bids involving labor will require Performance Bonds in the form of surety bonds only (no checks of any kind allowed). These bonds shall not only serve to guarantee the completion of the work, but also to guarantee the excellence of both workmanship and material until the work is finally accepted and the provisions of the Plans, Specifications, and Special Provisions fulfilled. In such cases, the company issuing the surety bond must comply with all stipulations herein and must be named in the U.S. Treasury listing of companies holding Certificates of Authority as acceptable sureties on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. Any excess between the face amount of the bond and the underwriting limitation of the bonding company shall be protected by reinsurance provided by an acceptable reinsuring company. Annual Bid and Performance Bonds on file with E & P Division must have sufficient unencumbered funds to meet current bonding requirements, or the bid will be rejected, unless the balance is submitted as set forth above, prior to bid opening.
- 5. **TAXES:** The ARDOT is not exempt from Arkansas State Sales and Use Taxes, or local option city/county sales taxes, when applicable, and bidders are responsible to the State Revenue Department for such taxes. These taxes should not be included in bid prices, but where required by law, will be paid by the ARDOT as an addition thereto, and should be added to the billing to the ARDOT. The ARDOT is exempt from Federal Excise Taxes on all commodities except motor fuels; and excise taxes should not be included in bid prices except for motor fuels. Where applicable, tax exemption certificates will be furnished by the ARDOT.
- 6. "ALL OR NONE" BIDS: Bidders who wish to bid "All or None" on two or more items shall so stipulate on the face of bid sheet; otherwise, bid may be awarded on an individual item basis.
- 7. **SPECIFICATIONS:** Complete specifications should be attached for any substitution or alternate offered, or where amplification is necessary. Bidder's name must be placed on all attachments to the bid.
- 8. **EXCEPTIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS:** Any exceptions to the bid specifications must be stated in the bid. Any exceptions to manufacturer's published literature must be stated in the bid, or it will be assumed that bidder is bidding exactly as stated in the literature.
- 9. **BRAND NAME REFERENCES:** All brand name references in bid specifications refer to that commodity or its equivalent, unless otherwise stated in Bid Invitation. Bidder should state brand or trade name of item being bid, if such name exists.
- 10. **FREIGHT:** All freight charges should be included in bid price. Any change in common carrier rates authorized by the Interstate Commerce Commission will be adjusted if such change occurs after the bid opening date. Receipted common carrier bills that reflect ICC authorized rate changes must be furnished.

- 11. **SAMPLES, LITERATURE, DEMONSTRATIONS:** Samples and technical literature must be provided free of any charge within 14 days of ARDOT request, and free demonstrations within 30 days, unless ARDOT extends time. Failure to provide as requested within this period may cause bid to be rejected. Samples, literature and demonstrations must be substantially the same as the item(s) being bid, unless otherwise agreed to by ARDOT. Samples that are not destroyed will be returned upon request at bidders expense. Samples from successful bidders may be retained for comparison with items actually furnished.
- 12. **GUARANTY:** Unless otherwise indicated in Bid Invitation, it is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped on this bid shall be newly manufactured, latest model and design, and in first class condition; and that all containers shall be new, suitable for storage or shipment and in compliance with all applicable laws relating to construction, packaging, labeling and registration.
- 13. **BACKORDERS OR DELAY IN DELIVERY:** Backorders or failure to deliver within the time required may constitute default. Vendor must give written notice to the ARDOT, as soon as possible, of the reason for any delay and the expected delivery date. The ARDOT has the right to extend delivery if reasons appear valid. If reason or delivery date is not acceptable, vendor is in default
- 14. **DEFAULT:** All commodities furnished will be subject to inspection and acceptance by ARDOT after delivery. Default in promised delivery or failure to meet specifications authorizes the ARDOT to cancel award or any portion of same, to reasonably purchase commodities or services elsewhere and to charge full increase, if any, in cost and handling to defaulting vendor. Applicable bonds may be forfeited.
- 15. **ETHICS:** "It shall be a breach of ethical standards for a person to be retained, or to retain a person, to solicit or secure a State contract upon an agreement of understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee, except for retention of bona fide employees or bona fide established commercial selling agencies maintained by the contractor for the purpose of securing business." (Arkansas Code, Annotated, Section 19-11-708).
- 16. **NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATION:** The Arkansas State Highway Commission, through ARDOT, complies with all civil rights provisions of federal statutes and related authorities that prohibit discrimination in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance. A. **General Specifications**:

- 1. <u>Current Model</u>: Units furnished under this specification shall be the latest improved model in current production, as offered to commercial trade, built for the U.S. market, and shall be of quality workmanship and material. Units manufactured for foreign markets will not be accepted. All equipment offered under this specification shall be new. Used, reconditioned, shopworn, demonstrator, prototype or discontinued models are not acceptable. Manufacturers of the units supplied must have been in the business of producing operational units for at least two years and must have recently sold similar units to domestic governmental agencies. The model furnished must have been in production for a minimum of one year, or be the latest version of a previous model. Bidder(s) will be required to submit documentation substantiating the aforementioned requirements. A list of user references may also be required.
- 2. <u>Literature</u>: Manufacturers literature, verifying adherence of proposed unit to each line item addressed in this specification, shall be submitted with the bid. If any literature and/or specifications of items conflict with ARDOT specifications, the conflict(s) shall be specifically noted, corrected and submitted with the bid.
- 3. Any deviations from specifications and requirements herein must be clearly pointed out by bidder. Otherwise it will be considered that the vehicle offered is in strict compliance with these specifications and requirements, and successful bidder will be held responsible therefore. Deviations must be explained in detail on an attached sheet. However, no implication is made by the Arkansas Department of Transportation that deviations will be acceptable.
- 4. <u>Manuals</u>: The successful bidder shall furnish one (1) Operator's Instruction Manual with each unit delivered and one (1) copy each of Shop Repair Manual and Parts Book to each FOB point.
 - The successful bidder may provide Shop Repair Manuals and Parts Manuals on computer media (CD, DVD, USB Drive, etc.) in lieu of printed manuals.
- 5. All parts, accessories and tools necessary for satisfactory operation of unit shall be furnished whether or not they are specifically mentioned in this specification (including standard equipment as regularly furnished by manufacturer as shown on printed literature and specifications unless specifically excluded by this specification).
- 6. <u>Parts Inventory & Service Facilities</u>: The successful bidder shall maintain a representative inventory of replacement parts and service facilities for servicing equipment bid on.
- 7. <u>Demonstration</u>: The Arkansas Department of Transportation reserves the right to require a demonstration, under actual working conditions, of equipment bid under this specification before award is made. The demonstration would be performed (free of any charge) by the bidder or an authorized representative at a mutually acceptable location. If requested, the bidder should be prepared to demonstrate the equipment within thirty (30) days after notification. Failure of the bidder to perform a satisfactory demonstration within the specified time may be grounds for rejection of the bid.
- 8. <u>Delivery Requirements</u>: It will be the responsibility of the successful bidder to guarantee delivery of the vehicle as specified, including items or equipment installed by a third party contractor, within the quoted time.
- 9. Cooperative Purchasing: Other tax-supported entities* in Arkansas (cities, counties, state agencies, school districts, etc.) may purchase from this Contract on an individual basis under the same specifications and conditions, and at the pricing set forth by each vendor, all at the discretion of each vendor in each case. Prices could be reduced by a vendor for minor alterations in conditions (changing order quantities, deleting options, etc.) as agreed by both parties, but could not be raised above the contract bid price except for any additional freight charges. Vendors would not be required to sell to any such entity under this contract, and those entities would not be obligated to purchase from the contract.

Each entity wishing to purchase from the contract must make contact directly with the appropriate vendor(s). The Arkansas Department of Transportation shall remain "out of the loop" for such transactions: all contact, orders, invoices, payments, etc. regarding such transactions must take place exclusively between the tax-supported entity and the vendor. The Department shall be held harmless of any and all liability arising from such transactions.

B. <u>Unit Specifications:</u>

- 1. <u>General:</u> This specification is intended to cover a police pursuit, four-wheel drive, four-door (SUV) utility vehicle. Vehicle must be evaluated with published results as a pursuit vehicle in the latest Michigan State Police or Los Angeles County Sheriff's Vehicle Evaluation Program. Vehicle furnished must be a current model built for the U.S. market and be designated by the manufacturer as a (PPV) Police Pursuit Vehicle. Substitutions will not be allowed. Vehicle must meet the following specifications at a minimum.
- 2. GVWR: No less than 7,400 pounds.
- 3. Payload: No less than 1,600 pounds.
- 4. <u>Trailering Capacity:</u> No less than 6,000 pounds.
- 5. <u>Speed Rating:</u> Shall have a projected forward pursuit speed rating of 124 miles per hour, and a projected reverse speed rating of 23 miles per hour, without additional equipment installed.
- 6. Wheelbase: No less than 120.9 inches, no more than 121.1 inches
- 7. <u>Body:</u> Four (4) door design and classified by the U.S. EPA as a standard SUV 4WD.
- 8. Frame: Fully boxed steel frame with high strength, steel roll formed, hydro formed and stamped rails.
- 9. <u>Engine</u>: Shall be of a naturally aspirated V-8 design with a minimum piston displacement of 5.3 liters. Shall be equipped with a high capacity dry type air cleaner, air filtration monitor system, full flow oil filter and fuel filter. Shall be equipped with a single system, single outlet exhaust.
- 10. Engine Cooling: Shall be equipped with a heavy duty high capacity radiator with electric fans and extended life coolant with freeze protection to -20° F minimum.
- 11. <u>Charging System:</u> Shall have primary and auxiliary 12-Volt maintenance free batteries with a 900 CCA primary and a 750 CCA auxiliary battery at minimum. Shall have a 250-amp alternator with a relay system to connect auxiliary battery to charging system. Shall have battery run down protection vehicle programming.
- 12. <u>Fuel:</u> Engine's primary fuel shall be regular gasoline rated at 87 octane minimum. Shall have a minimum fuel tank capacity of 24 gallons
- 13. Engine Oil Cooler: Shall be equipped with an engine oil cooler located in engine radiator assembly tank.
- 14. <u>Transmission:</u> Shall be equipped with a ten (10) speed automatic with gear ratios that work to improve both fuel economy and acceleration. Shall be of an electronic shift design with high performance programming.
- 15. <u>Transmission Oil Cooler:</u> Shall be equipped with an oil-to-air heat exchanger type oil cooler located in front of the engine radiator.
- 16. <u>Suspension:</u> Shall have a police rated, heavy duty, full independent suspension with mono-tube dampers and linear coil springs. Shall have heavy duty aluminum front underbody skid plates protecting front underbody components and engine oil pan. Front fascia shall have a minimum approach angle of 31.6 degrees and a vehicle rear departure angle of 18.1 degrees at minimum.
- 17. <u>Steering:</u> Shall have electric power steering consisting of a rack-and-pinion steering gear assisted by an electronically controlled power steering motor and drive assembly. Steering gear shall be connected to the steering wheel system.
- 18. <u>Front Differential:</u> Shall be equipped with a front differential and independent suspension system as regularly offered by manufacturer for police service four-wheel drive vehicles. Shall have a transfer case with the ability to engage and disengage front differential while vehicle is in motion. Shall have an electronic control switch easily accessible to the driver.
- 19. Rear Differential: Shall be equipped with a performance optimized, heavy duty, clutch type limited slip differential with a 3.23 axel ratio.
- 20. <u>Brakes:</u> Shall have power front and rear hydraulic disc brakes with an anti-lock (ABS) system. System shall be police specific with six (6) piston fixed front calipers on 410mm rotors, and rear single piston sliding calipers on 345mm rotors. Parking brake shall be as regularly furnished by manufacturer.
- 21. Wheels/Tires: Shall be equipped with four (4) pursuit and V-rated, all season, 275/55/R20 tires mounted on 20"x9" black steel wheels with a bolt on aluminum center cap. Shall have one (1) full size 275/55/R20 matching spare tire/wheel mounted in under-frame spare tire compartment. Shall include mechanical jack and all required tools needed to change out spare tire.

- 22. <u>Lighting:</u> Dual beam headlights, parking lights, self-canceling directional turn signals with hazard flasher switch, back up lights and side marker lights. Rear lights to consist of stop and tail lights in addition to directional signals. All lighting shall be as regularly furnished by manufacturer. Shall have head lamp and tail lamp emergency flasher system with calibration ability.
- 23. Spot Lamp: Shall have left (driver) side, factory installed, independently fused LED spot lamp.
- 24. <u>Cab & Interior:</u> Shall be complete with insulation and all standard interior trim, dual electric intermittent windshield wipers with washers, dual note horn, and factory installed electronic AM/FM radio. Shall have vinyl floor covering including rear cargo area. Shall have right and left sun visors, power windows, remote keyless entry, inside rear view mirror, and right and left side exterior mirrors as regularly offered by manufacturer. Exterior mirrors shall be heated and power-adjustable. Shall be equipped with factory installed tilt steering wheel, cruise control, and rear window defrost. Shall have full analog instrumentation as regularly furnished by manufacturer with a 140 mile per hour certified speedometer. Vehicle shall be equipped with driver and passenger air bags and crash curtains as regularly offered by manufacturer.
- 25. <u>Hands Free Communication:</u> Shall have factory installed Bluetooth with the ability to connect a cellular phone to the vehicles audio system for hands-free voice communication.
- 26. Special Service Switches/Locks: Rear window control switches and door lock switches shall be inoperative, with windows and locks operated from driver's position only. Interior rear door handles shall be inoperative, with doors being opened from exterior handles only. Door courtesy lighting shall have the ability to be disabled. Shall have surveillance mode lighting that shuts off all automatic lighting when activated. Shall have programing for a protected idle which will allow engine to remain idling and vehicle immobilized while key and or key FOB is outside of vehicle.
- 27. <u>Rear View Camera:</u> Shall be equipped with a factory installed rear view camera system with a display conveniently located to the driver. Vehicle shall have a rear parking assist feature.
- 28. Air Conditioning: Shall have factory installed front and rear air conditioning and heating system.
- 29. <u>Interior Lighting:</u> Shall have red and white auxiliary dome lighting mounted on headliner between first and second row seating.
- 30. Cab Glass: Manufacturers regularly furnished safety glass. All windows excluding windshield shall be deep tinted.
- 31. <u>Seating:</u> Front seating shall be 40/40 individual style cloth seats with deleted console. Second row rear seating shall be a vinyl, 60/40 split, folding bench seat. Third row seating shall be deleted. All seating shall have seat belts as regularly furnished my manufacturer.
- 32. <u>Additional Key FOBS</u>: A minimum of four (4) key FOBS and four (4) mechanical keys shall be provided in addition to manufacturer's regularly furnished FOBS. Key FOBS shall provide the following functions at a minimum: lock doors, unlock doors and ignition activation.
- 33. Exterior Accessories: Shall have molded black body mounted splash guards for all four (4) wheels. Shall have full length foot step-boards extending thru front and rear door areas. Exterior top luggage rack side rails shall be deleted.
- 34. <u>Trailering Equipment:</u> Shall have a factory installed SAE class IV receiver trailer hitch meeting vehicle GVWR requirements for payload capacity. Shall have a 7-wire harness with independently fused trailering circuits. Removable receiver hitch shall be 2 inch.
- 35. Electrical Wiring: Shall have emergency lighting wiring provision for outside mirrors and cargo side mirrors. Additional ground wires shall be added to body for radio suppression. Wiring provisions for grille lamps and siren shall be provided with provision for horn transfer loop siren circuit. Shall have a 100-amp power supply wired from auxiliary battery located in rear electrical center, and a 120-amp power supply with four (4) thirty amp circuits wired from primary battery located in passenger compartment harness. Shall have an additional 50-amp auxiliary battery power supply located in passenger compartment harness. Shall have two (2) 120-volt power outlets. One (1) harness located at front seating area, and one (1) outlet located in rear cargo area. Shall have a 12-volt front auxiliary power outlet located in center stack of instrument panel.
- 36. Color: Sherwin Williams F8W2030 Frost White Acrylic Enamel, or equal. Front bumper, rear bumper, grill, mirrors, wheels and hubcaps as regularly furnished by manufacturer. Interior and seating color shall be color keyed to exterior and as regularly furnished by manufacturer. Dealership and other vendor advertisement badges and/or decals are not acceptable, and shall not be installed.
- 37. <u>Fleet Free Maintenance Credit:</u> In lieu of free oil changes and tire rotations, credit shall be applied to invoice as a line item.

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- 38. <u>Satellite Tracking/Radio Delete:</u> Satellite tracking and owner convenience features shall be deleted. 4G LTE internet systems shall be deleted. SiriusXM radio shall be deleted.
- 39. <u>Warranty:</u> Vehicle shall have manufacturer's regular warranty. Warranty Data shall be furnished with each unit. The Warranty Data shall contain all necessary information such as motor and/or serial numbers and shall be signed by the selling dealer at the time vehicle is delivered to the Highway Department.
 - a) The vehicle and other incidental equipment purchased under this specification shall be warranted against defective material and workmanship for a minimum period of twelve (12) months (365 Days) from date unit is placed in operation by ARDOT. In addition, the manufacturer's advertised standard warranty period on vehicle components that exceeds the 12 months' warranty shall remain in effect.
 - b) Recent prior failure to provide warranty-work, parts, replacement parts or service, in a timely manner, for equipment from the same manufacturer or dealer shall be grounds for the rejection of any submitted bid, or for the denial of any otherwise qualified low bidder, whether such failure is attributable to the manufacturer or the dealer of the equipment. For the purposes of this paragraph "timely manner" means a period of time not exceeding thirty (30) calendar days to provide requested warranty-work, parts, replacement parts, or service. For the purposes of this paragraph "manufacturer" means the original manufacturer of the equipment and its successor or successors, regardless of number, and whether acquired by sale, merger, or otherwise. For the purposes of this paragraph "replacement part" means a part redesigned by a manufacturer to correct a design or engineering defect and which replacement part is capable of providing dependable performance in normal operation conditions for its normal service life without failure. Such bid or bids may be rejected by the Department until such failure or failures have been remedied to the satisfaction of the Department and until such manufacturer or dealer is providing such warranty-work, parts, replacement parts, and service in a timely manner.
