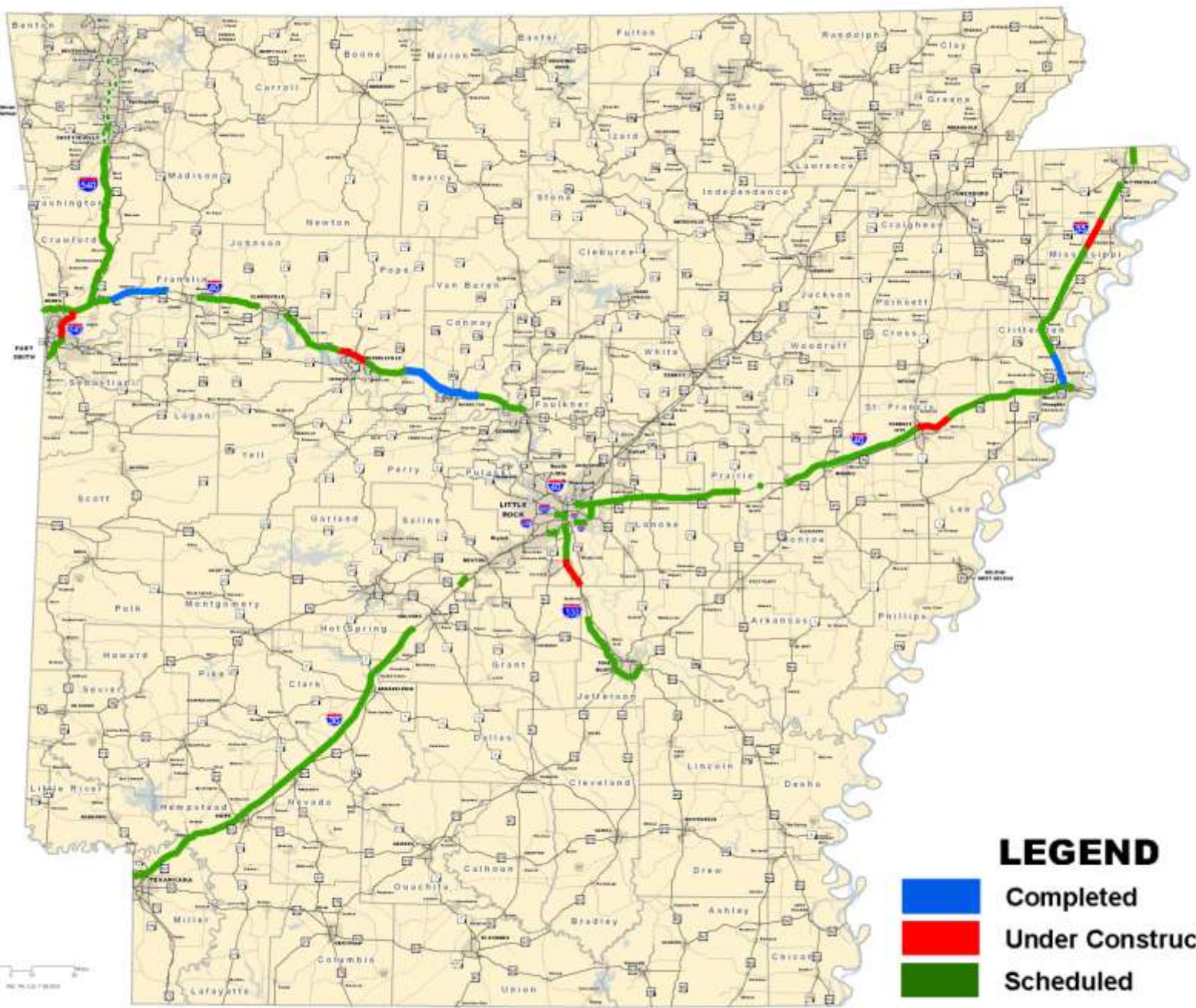

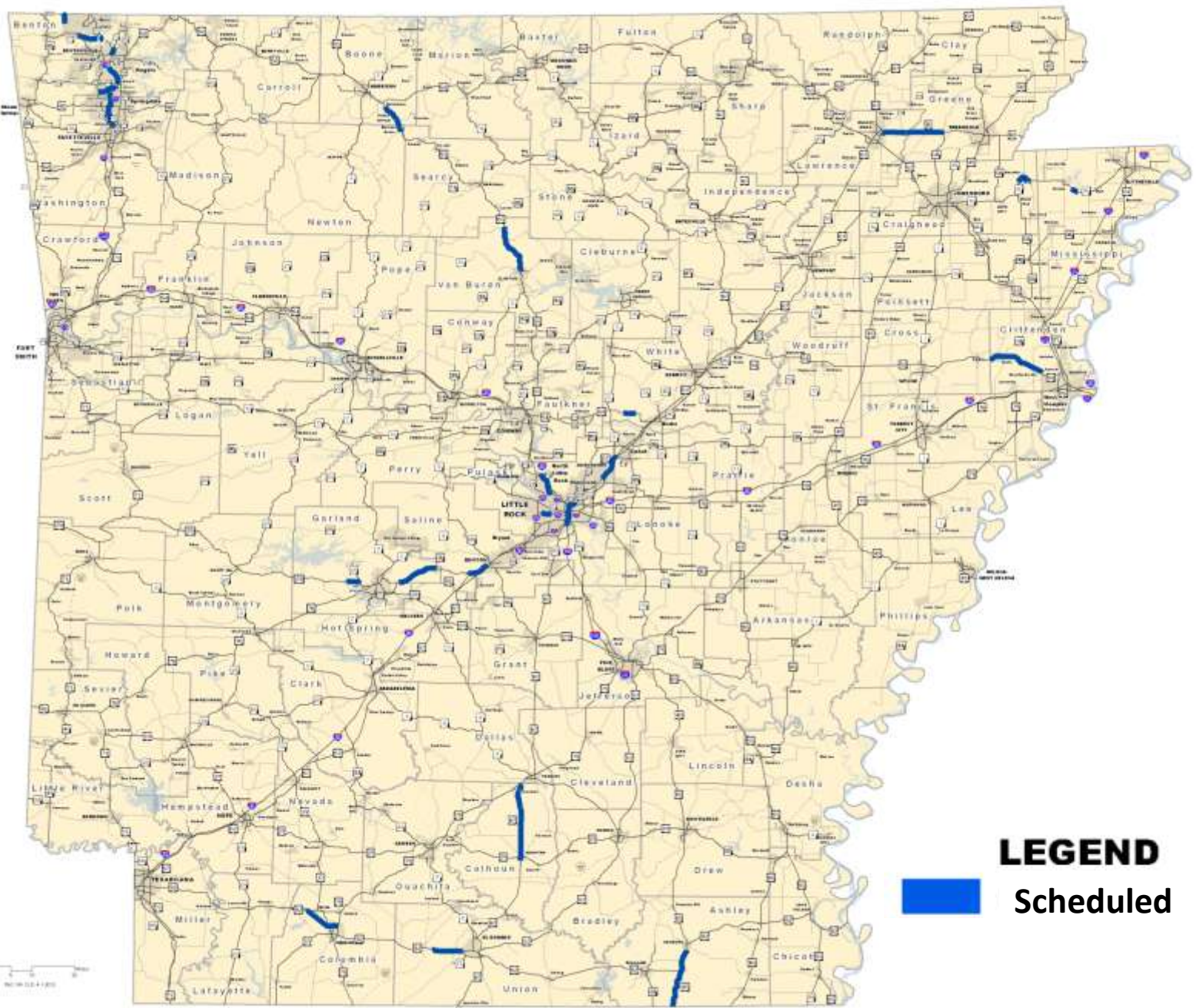

Interstate Rehabilitation Program Job Status



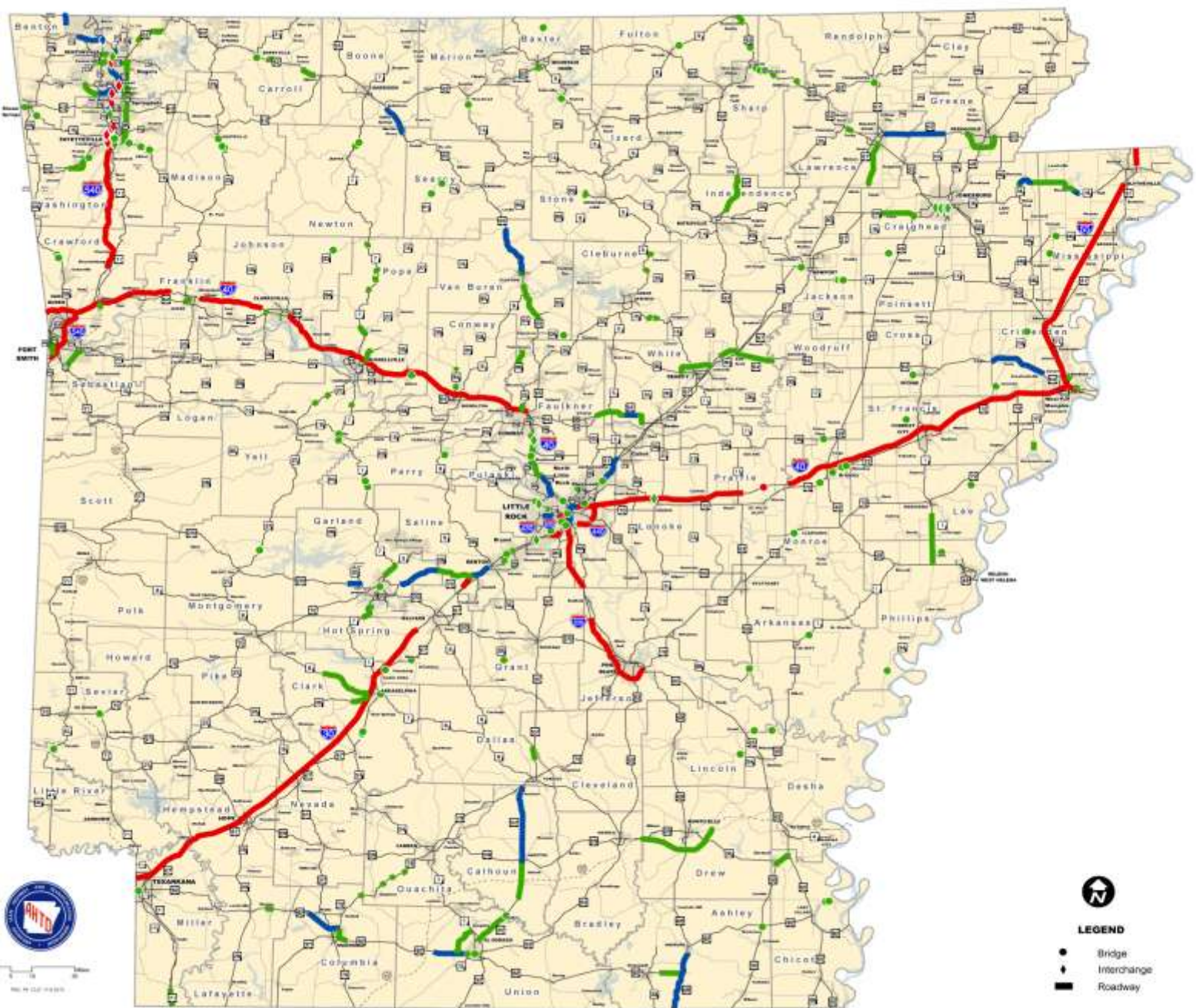

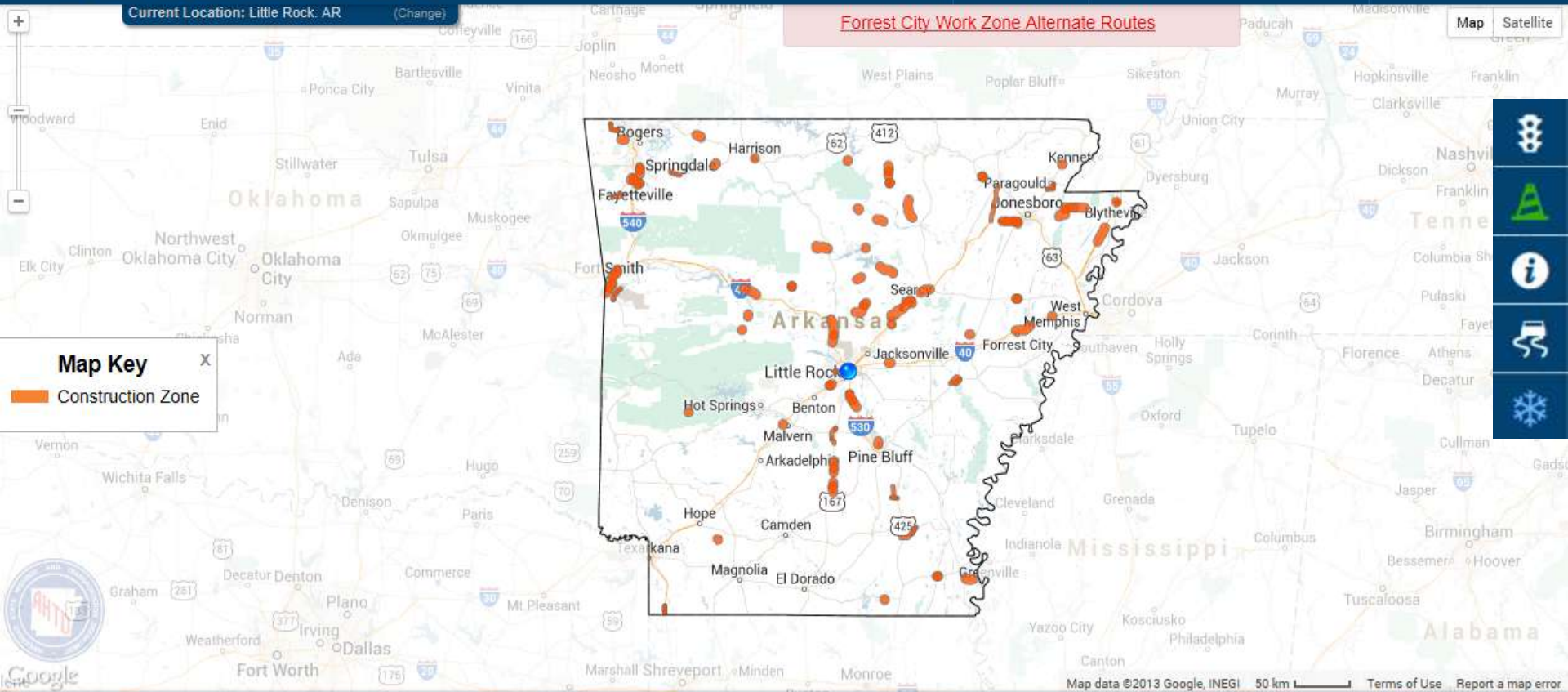

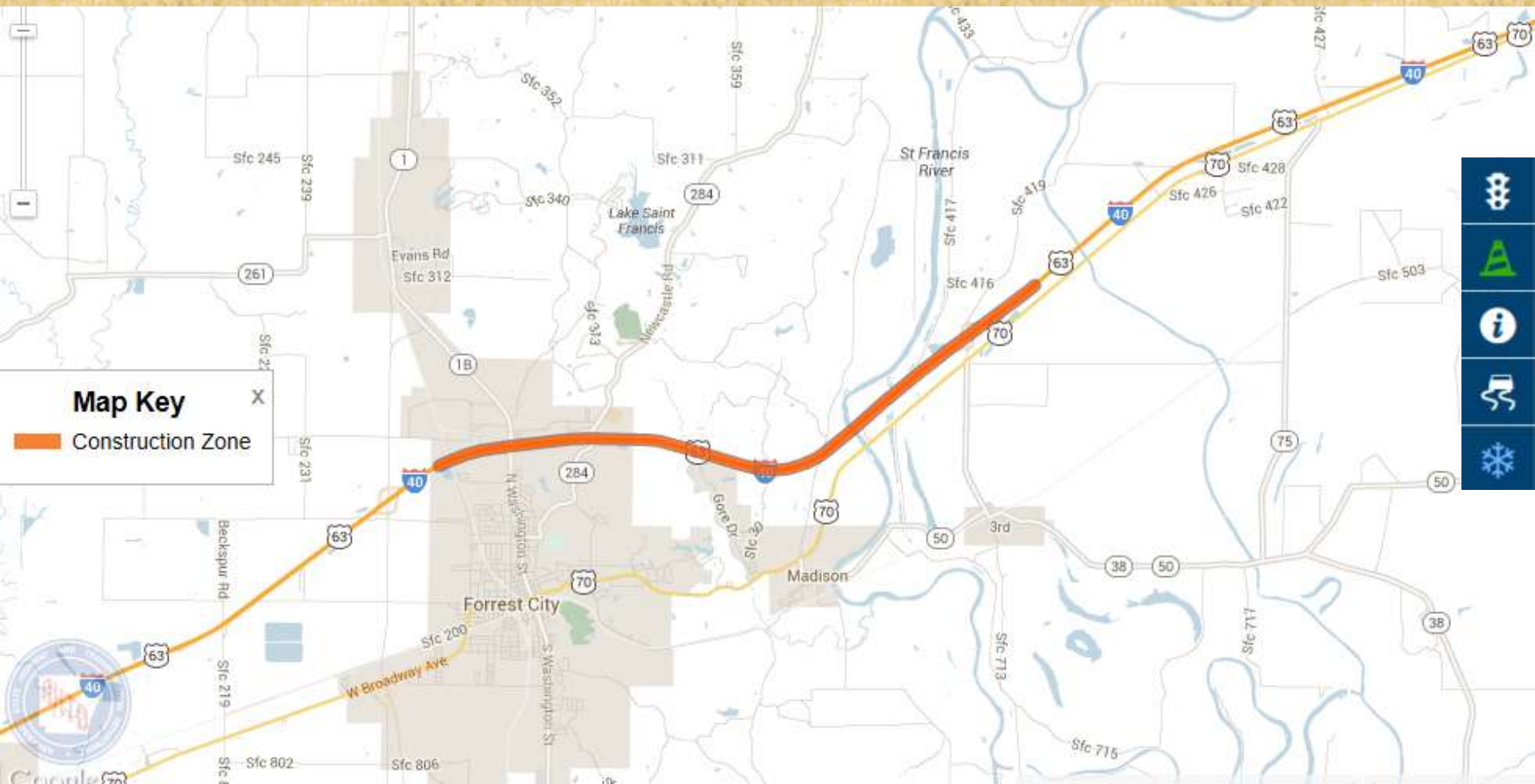

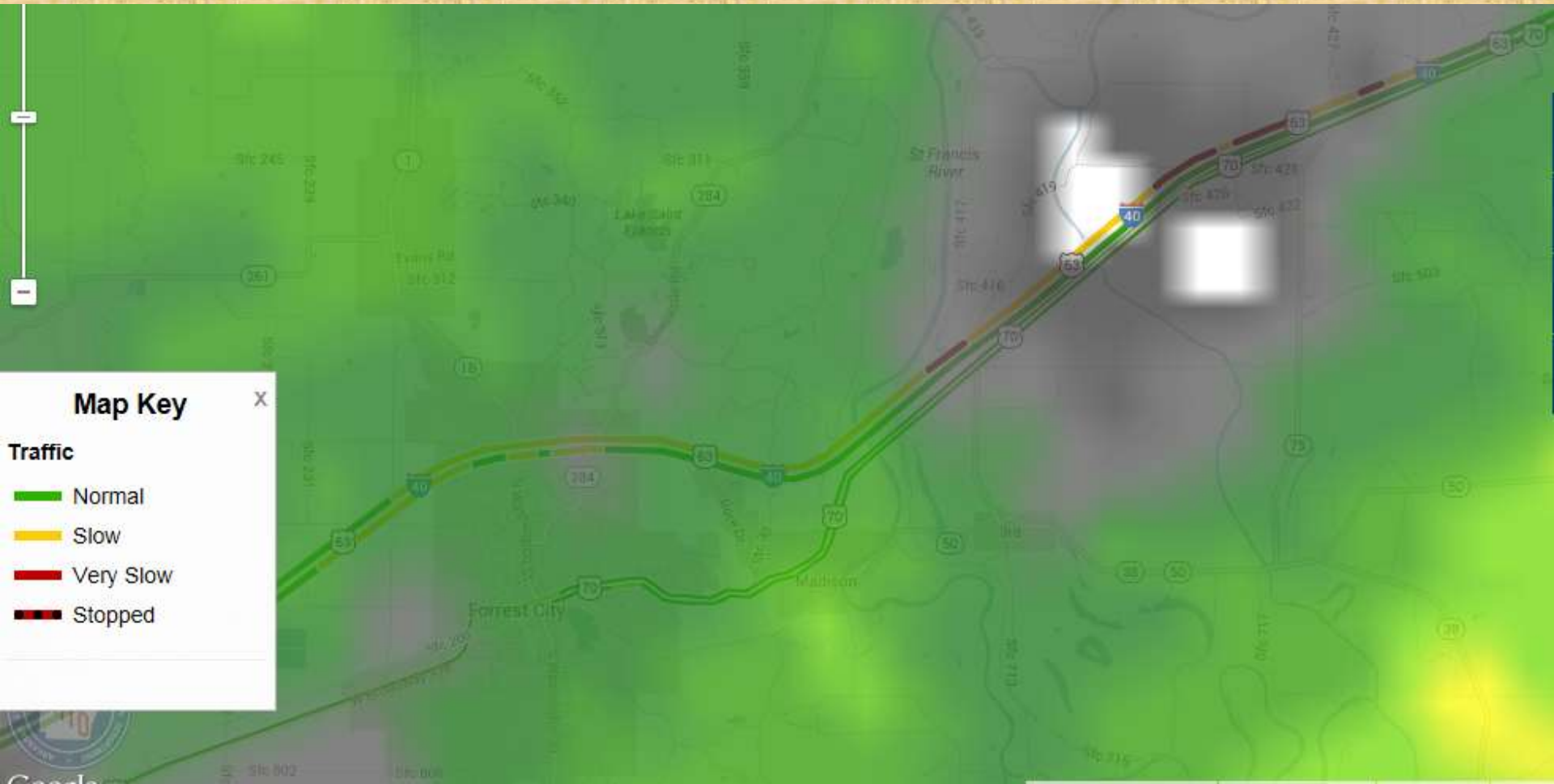

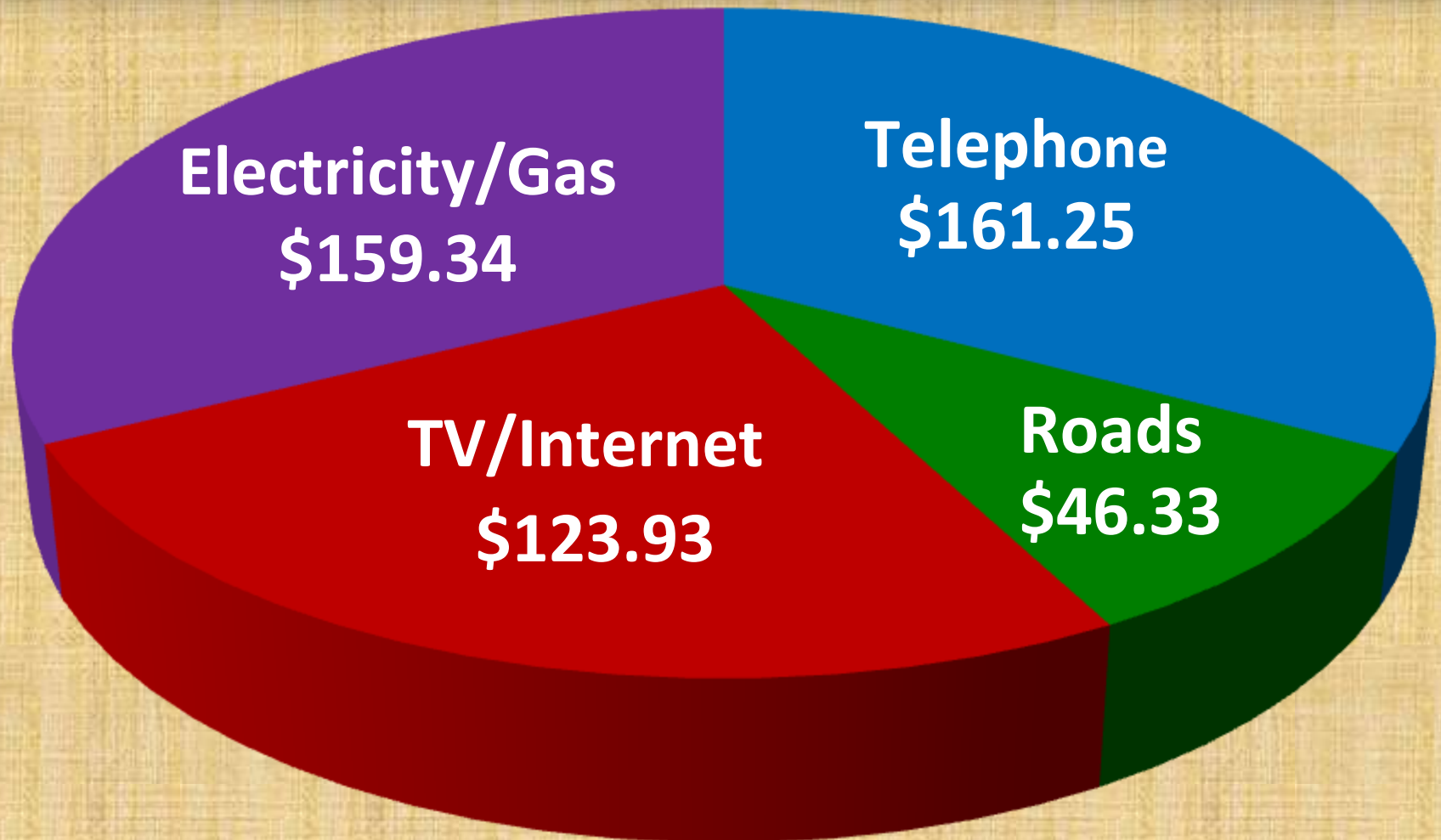
