

January 2014 Revenues and Consumption


- State highway revenue from most traditional sources down \$10.2 million for the first 7 months of SFY 2014

- Natural gas tax revenue up
- Result overall revenue down \$1.3 million for 2014

- Revenue from 0.5% Sales Tax under DF&A projections for 6 of 7 months
- > Total is \$2.8 million (3.2%) under projections




