


The Teens

- 36,000 Miles of Public Roads



Operation of the Henderson Ferry at Norfork Lake cost \$117,981 for 1947-48. During this period 189,856 vehicles were ferried over at an average cost of 62¢


- ✓ "the advice, counsel and expert know-how which



The Seventies



- Legislature transferred nearly 1,000 more miles
- South Teroff County Roads to Highway System Lawrence Blackwell burning bonds at a ceremony in 1975.
 - Department adds "Transportation" to its name Authority Expanded
 - 1.7 million Vehicles; 16,000 Highway Miles (15,000 Paved)


2015 Road User Related Tax Revenue

Total Road User Revenue Collected = \$1.12 Billion






2015 Road User Related Tax Revenue
