











Average Monthly Household Expenditures



- >\$9.3 billion in needs





Federal Highway Funding Issues


President Trump's Infrastructure Plan

- Infrastructure Incentives Initiative \$100 Billion or 50%
- Transformative Projects Program \$20 Billion or 10%
- Rural Infrastructure Program \$50 Billion or 25%
- Federal Credit Programs \$14.1 Billion or 7.05%
- Federal Capital Financing Fund \$10 Billion or 5%
- Public Lands Infrastructure Fund
- Disposition of Federal Real Property
- Private Activity Bonds

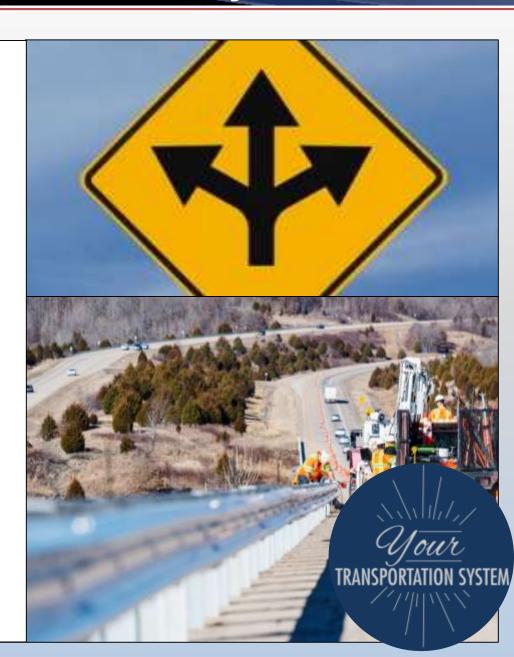










Are you satisfied with the condition of the existing highway system?




Would you support a new highway program that would generate additional revenue?
