
Challenges

- 12th largest system in the country
- 41st in highway revenue per mile

Next 10 Years:

- \$9.3 billion
 (\$930 million/year)
 in Needs
- \$4.5 billion (\$450 million/year) in Revenue
- \$4.8 billion (\$480 million/year) Shortfall

Percent of Highway vs. General Revenue





\$10,000,000 Overlay Program

THEN

In 1998, **200 lane miles** of highway could be overlaid with \$10 million.

NOW

In 2018, **90 lane miles** of highway could be overlaid with \$10 million.








Governor's Working Group on Highway Funding

Governor's Highway Funding Working Group

Funding Targets

- ✓ Immediate: \$ 50 Million
- ✓ Short-term (0-3 years): \$110 Million
- ✓ Mid-term (3-5 years): \$250 Million
- ✓ Long-term (6-9 years):

\$400 Million

All figures are annual amounts for state highways.



Current Connecting Arkansas Program

- Voter Approved in 2012
- Provides Temporary Half-Cent Sales Tax
- ARDOT Revenue Dedicated to CAP Projects
- County and City Revenue for Local Roads
- Expires June 2023







ARDOT - Educate Voters

Roads and Bridges Coalition - Campaign

- The cost of the current 1/2 cent sales tax for the average family with a median income is about \$8/month
- If Issue 1 passes, the cost to the taxpayers will remain the same as it is now.
 - No Increase
 - No Decrease
- This tax does not apply to groceries and it can only be used for road improvements.



Arkansans Need to Decide How to Fund
