#### **THEN**


In 1998, **200 lane miles** of highway could be overlaid with \$10 million.

Provides Temporary Half-Cent Sales Tax


Expires June 2023







#### **Baxter County**

2023 - \$2.1 Million

2024 – \$1.5 Million

Loss of Funding – \$600,000 Per Year

#### **City of Mountain Home**

2023 - \$1.0 Million

2024 - \$0.7 Million

Loss of Funding – \$300,000 Per Year
