**Trail Improvements McKissic Creek Park Trail and Allen Road Trail

SEALED PROPOSALS will be received on behalf of the City of Centerton at the office of Morrison Shipley Engineers, Inc., (2407 SE Cottonwood Street, Bentonville, Arkansas 72712) and read aloud at 10:00 am on Tuesday, March 23, 2021 for the **Trail Improvements McKissic Creek Park Trail and Allen Road Trail** project. The proposals shall be accompanied by a bid bond, certified check, or other negotiable instrument equivalent to five (5) percent of the amount of the bid.

THE PROJECT includes, but is not limited to the following general items of work:

The removal of an existing asphalt walking trail, corrugated plastic drainage pipe, concrete-lined ditch paving, and the construction of a concrete multi-use trail, installation of reinforced concrete pipe and flared end sections, installation of area inlets, junction box and reinforced concrete pipe. The project will generally start at the east end of the McKissic Creek Park lake dam and extend northward through the park and along the west right-of-way of Allen Road.

The City of Centerton hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Acts of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply

Because Federal highway funds are included in this project, "Buy America" requirements, as specified in Title 23 of the United States Code Section 313 and Title 23 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 635.410, apply to this project. This requirement applies to all steel products used on the project.

Registration and good standing in the System for Award Management (SAM) will be required prior to contract execution.

Since this is a Federal-Aid project, bidders are not required to be licensed when the bid proposal is submitted. However, the bidder must have the license in time to sign the construction documents

Each bid must be accompanied by an acceptable form of bid guarantee in an amount equal to at least 5% of the entire bid amount as set out in the Instructions to Bidders.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive formalities in the bidding forms. Late Bids will not be considered.

No bid may be withdrawn within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.
