**ELEVATIONS ON BRIDGE PLANS** 

We believe that it would be beneficial to provide the pertinent elevations for the

substructure bent caps, abutments and decks on the bridge plans. The elevations needed are

the corners of the caps, beam seats and centerline and gutter line elevations of the finished

deck at construction joints, quarter points or tenth points. We feel that with these elevations

shown on a drawing the bridge inspectors will have the information necessary to verify any

calculations they make and that this will enable them to more readily set the correct grade. It

might be best to provide an individual plan sheet just to show the grades on a schematic

drawing.
