SUBJECT: Detour Bridges

SUPERATE is not to be used for checking the design of temporary bridge structures (detour bridges) unless it can be determined that the timber materials to be used by the contractor have an allowable stress equal to or greater than the 1800 psi allowable in this computer program.

Our standard drawings for temporary Bridge Structures are based on a minimum allowable stress of 1200 psi.
