SUBJECT: SIDEWALKS

As you are aware, our policy in the past has been to only replace existing sidewalks. The Federal Highway Administration has pointed out that this policy is not in conformance with FHPM 6-2-5-2 and the Green Book.

Therefore, on future Federal Aid projects, consideration must be given to the construction of Sidewalks where current or projected pedestrian traffic indicate a need. This does not mean sidewalks are to be constructed indiscriminately. It does mean they must always be considered and constructed where absolutely needed.
