Notice is hereby given that the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (Department) is seeking letters of interest from qualified firms to collect condition data for pavements and other transportation assets along various highways in Arkansas. The services will be on an as-needed basis for a period of three years.

The work will generally consist of the following work:

- Automated Pavement Condition Data Collection
  - International Roughness Index (IRI)
  - Rutting
  - o Faulting
  - o 3D Cracking
  - Macro Texture
  - o Right of Way Imagery
  - 3D Pavement Imagery
  - o Roadway Geometry
- Other services related to Transportation Asset Inventory and Condition

The consultant selection for this letter of interest will follow the Department's *Consultant Selection Procedures 05/27/2010*. After a review of all letters of interest received, selected firms will be furnished a scope of work and be requested to submit proposals for accomplishing the work. Final selection will be announced following the Arkansas State Highway Commission action in April 2017.
