Notice is hereby given that the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (Department) is seeking letters of interest from qualified consulting firms for on-call services in conducting Phase I, Phase II and Phase III archeological investigations for various highway projects on an as-needed basis in Arkansas.

The work will generally consist of conducting archeological studies and reports based on available data, additional data collection, data analysis, and the appropriate documentation of findings. The contract duration is for a period of two years, but it may be extended up to an additional three years.

Individuals in charge of the project shall meet the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Qualifications Standards for Archeology and be Register of Professional Archaeologist (ROPA) certified. Firms must also have past experience and expertise in Arkansas archeology.

The letter of interest shall include the following information.

- Cover letter, no more than one (1) page.
- Proposed organizational structure for each task the consultant is interested in performing, including the primary contact.
- Description of the qualification of proposed project manager(s) and key team members (prime and sub consultants). This information shall be limited to one (1) page, 8.5" x 11" paper, with minimum 11-point fort for each task.

Following their review, the Committee will prepare a short list (minimum of three) of top ranked consultants and recommend to the Chief Engineer that these firms submit detailed proposals for further evaluation.

After a review of all letters of interest received, selected firms will be furnished a scope of work and be requested to submit proposals for accomplishing the work. Final selection will be announced following the Arkansas State Highway Commission action on November 30, 2016.
