Notice is hereby given that the City of Marion, Arkansas is seeking proposals from qualified consultant firms to provide professional services for the right of way and easement acquisition of properties for the BNSF Railroad Overpass (Marion)(F), ARDOT Job No. 110509, Federal Project No. SEC STOP STPD 9278(6).
