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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN LINCOLN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-16) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Lincoln County, according to Commission Vice Chairman R. Madison Murphy of El Dorado.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 5.4 miles of Highway 425. R.M. Courson, Inc. of Hamburg, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$1,192,191.41.

“This resurfacing project will improve selected sections of Highway 425 in the vicinity of Star City,” stated Murphy.

Murphy said work could begin on the project in six to eight weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected by August 3, 2009.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provides Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
