ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CLARK COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (1-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Clark County, according to Commission Vice Chairman R. Madison Murphy of El Dorado.

The purpose of the project is to install traffic signals at the eastbound and westbound interchanges on Interstate 30 at Highway 7, in the city of Caddo Valley. L.E.G. Enterprises, Inc. of Cabot, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$146,904.11.

"These new signals will make this a safer interchange for motorists passing through the area," stated Murphy.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
