LITTLE ROCK (4-27) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Public Involvement meeting in Newport to discuss plans for a new bridge across the White River, according to AHTD officials.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, May 3rd from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., in the Fellowship Hall of First United Methodist Church, 217 Laurel Street, in Newport.

Plans call for replacing the existing Highway 367 Bridge over the White River in Newport with a new two-lane structure.
