AHTD TO HOLD LOCATION PUBLIC HEARING IN CONWAY

LITTLE ROCK (7-27) - The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Location Public Hearing in Conway to discuss plans for the relocation of a section of Highway 25 north of Interstate 40, according to AHTD officials.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 9th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at the Conway Parks & Recreation Department (Basketball Court), 10 Lower Ridge Road, in Conway.

Plans call for relocating a section of Highway 25 on the northern edge of Conway. Several new location alternatives will be shown at the meeting.
