### **AHTD TO HOLD PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING IN MAYFLOWER**

**LITTLE ROCK (6-20)** - The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Public Involvement Meeting in Mayflower to discuss plans for constructing a new Union Pacific Railroad overpass on Highway 89 (Miller Street/Arkansas River Trail) in Mayflower. The work could result in a realignment of Highway 89 near the overpass, according to AHTD officials.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 25th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at Mayflower Elementary School, in the Cafeteria. The school is located at 4 Grove Street in Mayflower.
