2013 ARKANSAS HIGHWAY MAPS NOW AVAILABLE

LITTLE ROCK (6-20) – The 2013 Arkansas State Highway Map is now available from the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), according to AHTD Director Scott Bennett.

The cover of the new map features Highway 309 at Mount Magazine, in Logan County. The map includes the latest roadway and city population changes. In addition, more detailed maps of popular Arkansas cities as well as a chart showing mileage between cities and towns. Also featured is a Directory of Public Recreation Areas featuring State Parks, and Historic Memorials, National Parks, National Forest Recreation Areas and Corps of Engineers Parks.

Attached to this media advisory is a complete list of revisions on the 2013 Arkansas Highway Map as well as a photo of the cover.

The maps may be obtained, at no charge, at any Highway Department District Headquarters across the state and at all Arkansas Welcome Centers.
