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IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 430 REQUIRE WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE AT "BIG ROCK" INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (8-23) – Improvements to Interstate 430 require weekend northbound lane closures at the Interstate 430/630 "Big Rock" interchange in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be installing sign structures over the northbound lanes of Interstate 430 within the confines of the interchange. The work will require northbound traffic to be reduced to a single lane.

The closures will be Saturday night, August 24th through Sunday morning, August 25th between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Here's what drivers should know:

- > Northbound I-430 Drivers will be reduced to one lane. Below is a list of conditions that will be in effect during this closure.
 - Drivers exiting northbound I-430 to Shackleford Road (Exit 5) should be minimally impacted.
 - Drivers entering northbound I-430 from Shackleford Road must yield prior to entering I-430.
 - Drivers exiting northbound I-430 to eastbound I-630 must use caution when exiting. Drivers must quickly move over to the right to exit due to the location of the installation work.
 - There will be periodic 15-minute stoppages of traffic as the sign structures are being placed over northbound I-430.
