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BRIDGE PAINTING REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. HIGHWAY 67 AND RACE STREET IN SEARCY

LITTLE ROCK (8-30) – Bridge painting will require lane closures on U.S. Highway 67 and Race Street in Searcy, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be hanging equipment and painting the U.S. Highway 67 overpass. Work was scheduled to start Thursday, but was delayed.

The work will require the closure of one northbound lane on Highway 67, and possibly a southbound lane. It will also close one eastbound and one westbound lane on Race Street. Both closures will be Tuesday, September 3rd between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

Work will resume Wednesday, September 4th between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., weather permitting. The overnight work will continue for two weeks. During this period, only one eastbound and one westbound lane of Race Street will be closed.
