ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN HOT SPRING COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-22) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Hot Spring County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and Hot Spring County Judge Bill Scrimshire. The purpose of the project is to re-construct 1.7 miles of County Road 147 (Henderson Rd.) The work will extend north from Highway 270 to Highway 51, east of Magnet Cove.

Cranford Construction Company of North Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$217,432.40.

Construction is scheduled begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The job should be complete December 19, 2014.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.
