SIGN REPLACEMENT REQUIRES RAMP CLOSURE AT INTERSTATE 430/630 "BIG ROCK" INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (2-14) – Overhead sign replacement will require a ramp closure at the Interstate 430/630 "Big Rock" Interchange in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing a sign over the southwest loop ramp. The work will require closing the ramp. Interstate 630 eastbound traffic will be detoured to the Shackleford Road overpass. Drivers will then proceed north along Shackleford Road to Financial Centre or along I-430 North to I-630 toward their destination.

The ramp closure will be Tuesday night, February 18th through Wednesday morning, February 19th, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
