IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 40 WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-12) – Improvements to Interstate 40 will require lane closures in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be repairing slopes along Interstate 40. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes between mile markers 198 & 202, near the White River.

The eastbound lane closures will be Monday, September 15th and Tuesday, September 16th, between 6:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

The westbound lane closures will be Wednesday, September 17th through Friday, September 19th, between 6:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
