ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN LONOKE AND WHITE COUNTIES

LITTLE ROCK (4-27) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Lonoke and White counties, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 2.5 miles of roadway in Ward (Lonoke County) and 1.8 miles of roadway in McRae (White County). The locations are listed below.

Rogers Group, Inc. of Nashville, Tennessee was awarded the contract at \$459,123.95.

This project is being funded through the State Aid City Streets Program approved by lawmakers in 2011 and voters in 2012. This program provides \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a 9-member panel of Arkansas mayors.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this summer.
