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IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 430 RAMP REQUIRES WEEKEND LANE CLOSURES IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (3-25) – Improvements at the Interstate 40/Interstate 430 interchange in North Little Rock will require weekend lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will pour concrete on the I-430 north to I-40 west ramp. The work will require closing the ramp's inside lane north of the Maumelle Exit to I-40 west to place a temporary precast barrier wall and concrete pavement. Once the concrete work is complete, the barrier wall will be moved back to its original position and the northbound lane reopened. Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and barrels.

The lane closure will begin Friday, March 27th at 9:00 p.m. and continue through Monday, March 30th at 7:00 a.m., weather permitting.

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and completes the widening of Interstate 40 between Conway and North Little Rock. The project widens I-40 to three lanes in each direction. The project is anticipated to be complete in 2016. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
