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### **IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 30 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN SALINE COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (4-24)** – Improvements to Interstate 30 will require overnight lane closures in Saline County, according to the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD).

Crews will begin by patching existing concrete and strengthening the inside shoulder of Interstate 30 westbound. This will allow them to install a temporary concrete barrier wall. Once it is installed, crews will begin reconstructing 2.9 miles of the outside westbound lane of Interstate 30. The work will extend west from Highway 70 to near the Old Military Road to Highway 67 overpass (mile markers 111-108).

The lane closures will be **Monday night, April 27<sup>th</sup> through Saturday morning, May 2<sup>nd</sup>**, between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Weaver-Bailey Contractors, Inc. of El Paso, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$11,836,454.19. The project should be complete early 2016.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
