IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-19) – Improvements to Interstate 630 require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be sawing and patching pavement on Interstate 630 westbound. The work will extend from John Barrow Road to the access ramp to Interstate 430 northbound. The work will reduce Interstate 630 westbound traffic to two lanes within the work zone.

The lane closures will begin **Sunday night, June 21**st **through Friday morning, June 26**th, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using, barrels, electronic message boards and warning signs.
