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IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 40 AND THE INTERSTATE 40/430 INTERCHANGE REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-26) – Construction work on Interstate 40 and at the Interstate 40/430 interchange in North Little Rock will require overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The contractor will be erecting structural steel for the Norman Road and Marche Road bridges and placing concrete on the I-430 north to I-40 west bridge deck. The work will require alternating closures of the eastbound and westbound lanes of I-40 between mile markers 143.5 and 148. The work will include short, intermittent stoppages of eastbound and westbound traffic while work is performed over the travel lanes.

The lane closure will be **Monday night, June 29th through Wednesday morning, July 1st**, weather permitting. The closures will be in effect from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., with short traffic stops occurring intermittently between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each night. Traffic will be controlled using, barrels, electronic message boards and warning signs.

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 5.1 miles of Interstate 40 to 3 lanes in each direction. The work will extend east from Highway 365 to Interstate 430. The project is anticipated to be complete in 2016. More information on this \$38.4 million project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
