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SOIL TESTING REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON I-30 FRONTAGE ROAD IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (10-1) – Crews taking soil samples will require a lane closure on the Interstate 30 to Interstate 40 eastbound frontage road in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Work will require closing the eastbound inside lane of the frontage road within the work zone between log miles 142 and 143. The contractor will be taking core samples that will impact eastbound traffic at Locust Street. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and advance warning signs.

Weekend daily closures will be **Saturday, October 3 through Sunday, October 4 between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

Weekday daily closures will be **Monday, October 5 through Friday, October 9 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

This work is part of AHTD's proposed project to widen I-30 in Little Rock and North Little Rock between Interstate 40 and Interstate 530, including the Arkansas River Bridge, as well as improvements to I-40 from JFK Boulevard to Highway 67.
