Routine Inspection Requires Lane Closures on State Highway 440

PULASKI COUNTY (4-25) – A routine inspection of the State Highway 440 Bridge over Ink Bayou in Pulaski County will require temporary lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

- The outside eastbound lane will be closed between Exit 11 (I-40) and Exit 12 (State Highway 161) **Tuesday, April 26** from **9:00 a.m.** through **3:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.
- The outside westbound lane will be closed between Exit 11 (I-40) and Exit 12 (State Highway 161) **Wednesday, April 27** from **9:00 a.m.** through **3:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
