Improvements to Interstate 430 Require Overnight Lane Closures in Pulaski County


PULASKI COUNTY (7-29) – Construction work on the I-430/Interstate 30 interchange requires overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

This work will occur from **Sunday, August 28**, through **Tuesday, August 30** on the ramp carrying traffic from <u>I-430 southbound to I-30 westbound</u> (Exit 129-B) and will be closed nightly between **10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.** Traffic will use the ramp as normal outside of the closure hours.

The closure only affects southbound I-430 traffic traveling to westbound I-30. Motorists will be directed by signage to take Exit 128 on southbound I-430 and proceed onto the I-30 north service road in front of the Outlets of Little Rock and Bass Pro Shop. Westbound I-30 traffic will then re-enter I-30 at the next entrance ramp. The attached map illustrates this detour route.

The exit ramp carrying traffic from southbound I-430 to eastbound I-30 (Exit 129-A) will remain unaffected by this work.
