UPDATE!! Improvements to Interstate 49 Require Overnight Lane Closures in Benton County

BENTON COUNTY (11-2) – Construction work on I-49 in Rogers and Lowell requires overnight lane closures on New Hope Road, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Continuing through **Friday morning, November 4**, bridge construction and concrete barrier placement will require lane closures on New Hope Road between South 46th Street and South Pinnacle Hills Parkway. One westbound lane will be closed, and the eastbound left-turn lane will be closed.

The overnight lane closures will occur on weekdays. The closures began **Tuesday night**, **October 18** and will continue through **Friday morning**, **November 4**, between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using signage and barrels.

This project (Job CA0901) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 5 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from Highway 264 in Lowell to New Hope Road in Rogers. More information on this \$38.7 million project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
