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### **Improvements to Interstate 49 Require Overnight Lane Closures in Washington County**

**WASHINGTON COUNTY (6-30)** – Construction work on I-49 in Springdale requires overnight lane closures on I-49, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Beginning **Tuesday night, July 5**, crews will mill existing pavement and resurface with new asphalt on northbound and southbound lanes between the Elm Springs Road Interchange (Exit 73) and Spring Creek Bridges (Mile Marker 75), south of Wagon Wheel Road (Exit 76).

The overnight lane closures will occur nightly starting on **Tuesday, July 5** and ending **Friday morning, July 8**, weather permitting. The inside and outside lanes will alternately be closed northbound and southbound. Traffic will be controlled using signage and barrels.

- Northbound I-49 lane closures will occur **between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.**
- Southbound I-49 lane closures will occur **between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.**

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 3.4 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from U.S. Highway 412 to Wagon Wheel Road in Springdale. The project is anticipated to be complete in late 2016.
