## SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO I-430 / I-30 INTERCHANGE RAMPS REQUIRE CLOSURES

**PULASKI COUNTY (6-2)** – Repairs to the High Friction Safety Treatments (HFST) on ramps carrying traffic between Interstate 430 and Interstate 30 require the ramps to be temporarily closed while the work is being performed, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation (AHTD) officials.

Motorists traveling through the area should be aware of the following work schedule.

- ➤ **Sunday, June 4 and Monday, June 5** between the hours of **8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.** the following mornings, one lane of the ramp carrying traffic from eastbound I-30 (Exit 129) to northbound I-430 will be closed. The two lanes will alternately close as work progresses.
- ➤ Tuesday, June 6 and Wednesday, June 7 between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following mornings, the entire ramp carrying southbound I-430 traffic (Exit 129-A) to eastbound I-30 will be closed. Traffic will be detoured at Exit 128 on southbound I-430 and routed along the frontage road to the Mabelvale West Road overpass where motorists can cross over and access eastbound I-30.
