Improvements to State Highway 18 (East Highland Dr.) Require Alternating Lane Closures in Jonesboro

CRAIGHEAD COUNTY (11-14) – Construction work to improve State Highway 18 (East Highland Dr.) in Jonesboro will require alternating lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will be performing asphalt work that will alternately close a single lane of traffic on State Highway 18 between Watt St. and Commerce Dr. starting on **Thursday, November 16 at 6:30 a.m.** Lane closures will occur weekdays and Saturdays from **6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.** until the project is complete, which is estimated to be three weeks.

Traffic will be controlled by signage, flaggers and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
