Routine Inspection on Interstate 40 Bridges over Mississippi River Requires Lane Closures between West Memphis and Memphis

CRITTENDEN COUNTY (9-5) – A routine inspection of the I-40 bridges over the Mississippi River between West Memphis and Memphis requires temporary lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; the following lane closures will take place on I-40 between West Memphis and Memphis:

- The outside westbound lane will be closed between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on
 - **Wednesday, September 6**
 - **Monday, September 11** through **Thursday, September 14**
 - **Monday, September 18** through **Thursday, September 21**

- The outside eastbound lane will be closed between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on
 - **Wednesday, September 13** through **Thursday, September 14**

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
