Work on Interstate 30 Requires Ramp Closure in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (12-14) – Crews performing work along the Interstate 30 corridor in Little Rock will require a ramp closure tonight, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the 6th Street on-ramp to eastbound I-30 for drainage work. This work will occur **tonight during overnight hours, from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** Traffic will detour to 4th Street and use the Cumberland on-ramp to access eastbound I-30.

Traffic will be controlled by signage, construction barrels, and barriers. The public is advised to be cautious when traveling in the work zone and **watch for slower traffic speeds**.
