Work Requires Lane Closures on Interstate 430 in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (07-10) - Pavement marking work on Interstate 430 will require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the Interstate 430 southbound outside lane in the area of the Big Rock interchange to install Interstate lane route shields. This work will occur Monday, July 13 and Tuesday, July 14, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Traffic will be controlled with construction barrels and signage. The public is advised to be cautious when traveling in the work zone and watch for slower traffic speeds.

This project (Job CA0608) is part of ARDOT's Connecting Arkansas Program, which is funded through a 10-year, half-cent sales tax. Interstate 630 has been widened for 2.2 miles between the Big Rock Interchange and University Avenue. The widening was substantially complete in March 2020.
