The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), will conduct an open forum Design Public Hearing to discuss the proposed design of the Hwy. 13 Extension from Hwy. 267 to Hwy. 36.
